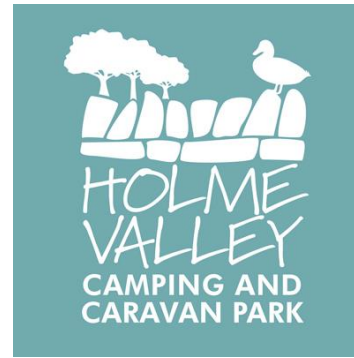


Tidy up Checklist



Please read through our checklist to help keep the park clean and tidy.

- Caravans and awnings should be cleaned regularly. We recommend every 6 to 8 weeks.
- Please do not insert nails, screws, hooks or brackets into trees or hang things from them as this will cause a weak point and over time is very likely to kill the tree.
- Please do not put washing lines up. Aswell as looking unsightly and damaging trees, this is a serious health and safety risk. Freestanding rotary lines with ground pegs are much safer and are available from various shops including Argos, Home Bargains and Amazon for between £16.00 to £30.00. If you would like us to order one for you, please see us. If washing lines remain up, we will remove them ourselves.
- Check around and underneath your caravan for any items that have no use or could potentially be unsightly or a hazard, for example pieces of wood, metal or plastic, parts of cars and old furniture.
- According to Fire and Safety Regulations there should be no more than two gas bottles (1 x 47kg and 1 x 19kg or 6kg changeover) outside each unit.
- Please do not chain the bottles together so that in case of a fire they can be easily moved.
- Empty gas bottles must be removed.
- Please remove any empty pots or unattended pot plants.
- Anything that is not classed as domestic waste must be disposed of by yourselves at the tip. These items cost the park money to dispose of if left in the bin areas.
