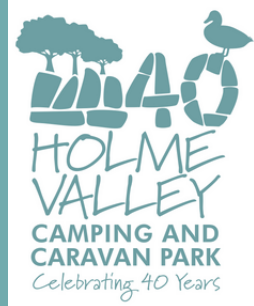

ANPR Barrier Installation

After a lot of consideration, we have decided to have an ANPR barrier installed close to the reception building. Work will be carried out during the second week in March and we have opted for a number plate recognition system which should keep things simple when entering the park. We will be contacting everyone to ensure we have up-to-date number plates.

Please ask in the shop for his contact details.

Snow can damage awnings - in case we are due some over the winter period, it would be worth strengthening these as best you can. We will do our best to keep an eye on them and get in touch if we need to.
