


Park Rules (Seasonal Pitch Holders)

1. On arrival, caravans must be pitched with the assistance of a member of staff to ensure ample spacing between units. If planning to purchase a new caravan, it must be checked by one of the park owners before a purchase is made.
2. Cars must be parked in their allocated parking space on the pitch. Cars should not be parked elsewhere or in other pitch holders' parking spaces even when vacant.
3. Only one vehicle per pitch is permitted (unless a further vehicle has been agreed by staff). Parking of any additional cars must be agreed by staff and not parked on vacant pitches. Vans should be agreed with one of the park owners before bringing onto the park. Large vans or other vehicles are strictly not permitted.
4. According to Fire and Safety Regulations there should be no more than two gas bottles (1 x 47kg and 1 x 19kg maximum) outside each unit. Gas bottles should not be chained together, and empty gas bottles must be removed.
5. Please do not put up, tie or attach washing lines or any other objects to trees or walls, these can damage or even kill trees. Rotary washing lines are permitted but must be kept on pitches and pegged down. These taken down after use.
6. Nothing should be attached to walls or trees of any description. No part of trees, bushes or plants should be cut, trimmed or altered. Please contact a member of staff if you have any issues with any plants or trees on the park.
7. Please keep outdoor lighting to a minimum, avoiding bright lights. Please check with park owners before buying or erecting any lighting.
8. There must be no alterations made to your pitch, such as erecting a shelter, without written permission from one of the park owners or managers. Permanent structures, such as flooring are strictly not permitted.
9. Please keep the area around the Caravan tidy. This will include:-
 - a) no flags, signs, animal shelters, for example pet hutches, kennels or cages.
 - b) outdoor belongings on your pitch may consist of outdoor seating and a BBQ. Pot plants must be kept to a maximum of 6 and any empty or unattended pots must be removed.
 - c) outdoor storage may consist of 1 or 2 storage boxes and must be agreed by us and kept in a good state of repair and condition.
 - d) during the time the Caravan is vacant, smaller items, such as outdoor candles, chair cushions, children's toys must be taken indoors and stored inside your Caravan or awning.
10. Campfires, chimeneas or makeshift fires in BBQs are not permitted on the park.
11. BBQs must stand well off the ground (minimum of 15cm.)
12. For guests own safety, do not use a BBQ in awnings.
13. No pet should be allowed to roam freely on the park. If bringing a cat, please ensure this is kept in the caravan.
14. Dogs must be kept on a lead or tied up on the park.
15. Dogs can be walked and let off the lead in the woodland, but please do not walk your dogs on the park and around the camping fields.
16. Please ensure you clean up after your pet.

17. Noise and music level must be kept to a low level at all times. No music after 9pm.
18. No noise after 10.00pm.
19. Cars must not exceed 5mph on the park and on the lane leading to the main road.
20. Electric or motorised 2-wheelers, including scooters, bicycles, mopeds and motorcycles are strictly not allowed to be ridden in the camping fields or around the park, unless entering or leaving the park camping field using the access lane within the speed limit of 5mph.
21. Children remain the responsibility of their parents or guardians at all times. It is particularly important that you always know where your children or any children staying with you are, and that you provide adequate supervision for them at all times. The use of water balloons is strictly forbidden.
22. Fishing tickets must be bought before fishing.
23. Please dispose of all litter in the bins provided and leave pitches clean and tidy when departing. Please recycle glass, metal cans, paper and cardboard in our recycling areas. Anything not deemed as domestic waste (what you would not put in your wheelie bin) must be disposed of by yourselves at the tip. These items cost the park money to dispose of if left in the bin areas.
24. Cigarette ends must be disposed of carefully and in the bins provided by the park.
25. To keep noise at an acceptable level, we only accept groups of up to 3 families or maximum 15 people on tourist pitches. This also applies to seasonal pitches. Any larger group gatherings of a size not allowed will be asked to leave.
26. No unaccompanied parties of teenagers. All guests under the age of 20 must be accompanied by an adult of parental age.
27. Our toilet and shower blocks are cleaned regularly but if at any time you are unhappy with the cleanliness of the toilet facilities or see any damage, please report it to reception immediately so we can rectify the problem.
28. Anyone being inconsiderate or spoiling the enjoyment of other guests will be asked to leave.
29. Our staff team have the right to be treated with respect. We operate a zero-tolerance policy and will not tolerate any swearing, threats or verbal abuse of any kind. Any pitch holder treating staff members in a disrespectful way will be asked to leave.
30. If vacating your pitch, please ensure:-
 - a) a date and approximate time of towing your caravan off is given with 48 hours' notice.
 - b) you adhere to the Instructions about vacating your pitch which will be issued in advance.
 - c) a member of staff is present on leaving to ensure the rules have been complied with.
 - d) you leave behind anything that was already on your pitch and remove all your belongings or items you brought to the pitch.
 - e) your electricity card is returned to the shop/reception.

Please note, when vacating your pitch, it is not permitted to sell your caravan or give away items from around your caravan to other pitch holders without checking with one of the park owners/managers.

31. Failure to comply with the park rules may result in the termination of a seasonal agreement. Holme Valley Camping and Caravan Park reserve the right to refuse seasonal bookings from any guest who has not complied with the Park rules in the past.
